CONFERENCE CALL

Dear colleagues!

We are pleased to invite you to participate in annual scientific and practical conference held since 1999 at the Institute of Environmental Engineering of the RUDN University. The event gathers scientists, specialists in the area of ecology, environmental management, safety and emerging situations, students, Ph.D. students and PostDoc researchers, as well as school teachers and their pupils.

Format: Oral sessions - in person and remotely, poster session - remotely on the conference website.

Conference languages: English and Russian.

CONFERENCE TOPICS

- **Bioecology** (*population structure and dynamics; succession process in ecosystems; key factors of ecological niche of plant and animal species; behavioral ecology and biological communication; influence of the anthropogenic factors on condition of ecosystems; bioindication*)
- **Soil aspects of rational environmental management** (*ecological functions and services of soils; influence of anthropogenic factors on soil condition; soil pollution and degradation, monitoring and evaluation of soil resources; soil carbon sinks and pools; rational use of soil and land resources, legislative and regulatory problems of their protection and use*)
- **Environmental geosciences and sustainability of geo-ecosystems** (*geo-ecological aspects of environmental management; geochemistry of the environment; monitoring of the state of environmental components; modeling and information technologies in environmental management*)
- **Environmental Safety and Resource Conservation Technologies** (*Development and application of modern environmental protection systems; energy-efficient, low-waste and resource-saving technologies; closed-loop production cycles; ecobiotechnology; renewable carbon-free energy; remediation of accumulated environmental damage*)
- **Environmental safety management** (*economic and legal foundations of rational nature management; green economy and closed cycle economy; state environmental policy and environmental legislation; rationing of environmental impact; problems of HSE-management implementation; identification and reduction of environmental risks; climate risks and climate projects*)
- **Food safety and greening of agricultural production** (*bio-fermentation of agricultural and processing industry waste; development of biological crop protection system; evaluation, development and practical application of entomophages, biopesticides, pheromones and attractants; technical regulation and environmental safety of products; products with improved environmental characteristics; products of organic production; optimization of production, processing and storage of agricultural crops*)
- **Human ecology** (*environmental factors and their impact on humans; problems of human adaptation to changed environmental conditions; management of adaptation abilities of the organism; environmentally conditioned pathologies; functional products*)
- **Ecology, philosophy, education** (*ecological philosophy; problems and ways of formation of ecological consciousness; modern educational technologies in the field of ecological and environmental education; development of the system of continuous environmental education*)

PUBLICATION OF CONFERENCE MATERIALS

Conference Proceedings – materials of the reports in the form of short papers (abstracts); the proceedings will be indexed article by article in the RSCI (Russian Science Citation Index) database; after the conference, it will be posted on the conference website in electronic format. Printing of paper copies of the proceedings is not provided. By agreement with the Program Committee, participation with an oral presentation without publication in the proceedings is allowed.

Special Issues of Higher Attestation Commission of Russia / Scopus Journals – based on the results of the conference, articles from selected reports will be offered for publication in journals according to their scope and published after peer review. Information about the journals will be sent in the second information letter and posted on the conference website. Selected articles based on the materials of the 2025 conference were published or are being prepared for publication in upcoming issues of the journals "Ecology and Industry of Russia" (No. 11/2025), "Geographical Environment and Living Systems", "Resources" (formerly "Waste and Resources"), and "RUDN Journal of Ecology and Life Safety".

- Submission of a file with the registration form and report abstract (100-150 words)

Submission of Report Materials: until March 31, 2026

- A file of the short paper, formatted according to the template, sent to the Organizing Committee's email address;
- For poster presentations – a poster file for posting on the conference website, formatted according to the template;
- Optional for participants – a file of a full-length article for consideration for publication in an issue of one of the journals dedicated to the conference results, following the journal's requirements.

**REQUIREMENTS FOR MATERIALS (SHORT PAPERS)
FOR PUBLICATION IN THE GENERAL CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS COLLECTION**

1. The material submitted for publication must meet the general requirements for scientific publications, containing an introduction, a brief description of the materials and methods of the research, a summary of the results obtained, and conclusions. However, sections within the paper are not to be highlighted.
2. For papers submitted by students (without co-authors from among the academic staff), a scientific supervisor must be indicated.
3. The "header" of the paper (authors, title, author affiliations) must be provided in Russian and English.
4. The paper must be accompanied by an abstract (up to 100 words) in Russian and English.
5. Format: A5 sheet (width 14.8 cm, height 21 cm). Portrait orientation; paragraph: indent 0.5 cm; single line spacing; Microsoft Office Word editor; Times New Roman font, size 12. Do not insert page numbers, do not use headers/footers. Do not use page breaks.
6. Recommended length: 5 pages in the specified format, including the "header," abstract, and references. The last page must be filled more than 50%. An increase in length is permissible if necessary, in agreement with the Organizing Committee and upon payment for the additional volume in accordance with the information on the registration fee amount.
7. References to literature (only scientific, including electronic resources) are given in square brackets [1, p. 10], [2] in the order they appear in the text. The reference list must be formatted according to the GOST R 7.0.100-2018 standard. For electronic resources, the DOI of the article or the URL (if no DOI is available) must be provided. For online resources, the access date must be provided. References to non-scientific sources – regulatory documents, organization websites – are given directly in the text of the paper. The reference list must contain at least 5 sources (of which no more than two may be authored by the report's presenters).
8. Formulas must be included in the text of the report using the formula editor built into WORD, placed centered, and numbered.
9. Figures must be inserted into the text, with a 6 pt space before the figure and a 6 pt space after the caption. If a figure is created using insertion and drawing tools, the elements must be grouped (move as a single object). For charts/diagrams, it is recommended to use hatching/patterns instead of color fills, as for black-and-white printing.
10. Inserting tables as scanned images is not allowed.
11. Figures (photographs) and tables must be numbered and have captions (Table 1. Caption – before the table; Fig. 1. Caption – below the figure); references to the cited figures and tables must be present in the text. Font sizes 11 or 10 may be used in tables.
12. It is strongly recommended to format the paper directly in the template, which can be found on the conference website or requested from the Organizing Committee.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ARTICLES FOR PUBLICATION IN SPECIAL JOURNAL ISSUES

are determined by the rules of the specific journal and will be sent to authors for preparing their article upon the recommendation of the Program Committee.
